Hospice Launches New Advertising Campaign

Peace. Comfort. Dignity. Freedom. These are the words heard over and over from Hospice family members and others as Hospice began planning for the next phase of its advertising campaign. After months of planning and conducting surveys, telephone interviews and several focus groups with patients, caregivers, and planners (people who have assisted in health care planning for others or who have experience in end-of-life care), Hospice's ad agency, Eric Mower and Associates, worked with the Hospice team to develop concepts to help people understand the value of Hospice care.

"The value of Hospice simply cannot be understood until you experience it, either directly or indirectly," stated John Richelsen, director of Marketing and Research Services at Eric Mower. "We

were hearing from people that there is almost a sense of relief with Hospice that there's now a medically and emotionally supportive 'community' in place."

"Quality of life needs to be there. You need to have dignity," commented one person in the planner focus group. "Hospice will help you in any way they can," said another. "They will talk to the doctor for you."

"We believe these messages will help people to think about Hospice as the support they need to travel their end-of-life journey with dignity," added Flynn. "Our team of professionals and volunteers truly deliver something special every day." ■

Making a Difference in the Grieving Process

The loss of a loved one is never an easy experience. When a child loses a loved one, the experience is especially painful and can have a significant physical, mental, and emotional impact on the child. Many times, grieving children exhibit changes in behavior, denial, sadness, and have trouble sleeping. It is important that children who have lost a loved one are given outlets to express their grief and cope with the loss.

Camp Blue Skies is an overnight camp for youth in Western New York who have experienced a death of a loved one three months to three years prior to the beginning of camp. At Camp Blue Skies, grieving children and teens are able to express their feelings and interact with professional grief counselors. The overnight camp, which is held at Cradle Beach in Angola, provides children with the opportunity to engage in a variety of therapeutic and recreational activities, including arts and crafts, music therapy, dance movement therapy, yoga, cooking, nature walks, a balloon launch, and many more. Aside from the \$25 registration fee per camper, there is no other cost to attend the camp. The stay includes transportation to and from Cradle Beach, all meals, activity supplies and accommodations. Camp Blue Skies will be held this year from September 24-25. ■



CEO's Message

Our community and our loved ones deserve better care at the end of life. It seems that several healthcare providers are starting to embrace palliative services in the community. While the proliferation of palliative care models can be helpful for patients and families, we are concerned limited types of care will develop. Here is a helpful guide if a healthcare organization offers their own version of comfort care or claims their services are the same as Hospice.

First, let me define palliative care. It's a model of care embraced by Hospice for decades as our primary clinical model and a way to ease the suffering of a patient and their family caregivers. Specifically, it involves the following: aggressive management of symptoms such as pain, delirium, and anxiety while providing practical support to the patient and family. Base line palliative care also involves a multi-disciplinary team to address the entire human being. This would include a nurse and physician to aggressively address physical symptoms, a social worker for patient advocacy, a chaplain to assist a patient's spiritual needs, and possibly a music or art therapist to help the patient and family find meaning beyond illness. Palliative care also recognizes the patient and family likely have a preference to be in a setting which is most comfortable. Hospice has the capacity to deliver services regardless of the patient's setting and we work very hard to accommodate the patient's wishes. Our care model also involves a team of volunteers to assist patients and caregivers as well as professionals who can counsel family members and loved ones before and after the patient's passing. If you recognize the comprehensiveness of these services, then you probably had a loved one in the Hospice program. Our mission in Western New York is to spread this comprehensive model of care in the community. Yet, we become concerned when we hear other healthcare professionals state "we perform the same palliative services as Hospice." But when you dig deeper into their model of care, it likely does not include the breadth and depth of services described above. If you hear a healthcare professional in our community dissuade you from Hospice because they claim to offer the same services, have them specifically describe those services and then decide for yourself. It's your community, it's your loved one, you deserve the best. ■

Resilient Elder Loves Hospice

Regina Markowitz is a survivor. It's not that she is 85 years young or that she remains content despite her serious illness. It's her incredible story of surviving the Holocaust.

The morning of our *Journeys* interview, Regina is clad in her apron, cooking her homemade 'chicken' Gefilte fish, a variation of her Yiddish tradition of eating the poached fish mince she enjoys on holidays and the Sabbath. Her Hospice home health aide, Maddy, is in the kitchen assisting her.

Diagnosed with pulmonary hypertension in 2007, Regina was admitted to Hospice home care in May, 2010.

"She was very uncomfortable and in a lot of pain. I had seen hospice ads that indicated that Hospice could help deal with pain. So I thought I should have someone come in and evaluate her in terms of pain management," noted Deb Shiffner, Regina's daughter. "We have started using Dr. Maher, the hospice physician, as our primary physician. She came up with an excellent drug that my mother tolerates extremely well and it's stopping a lot of her pain. Hospice has been very positive. When we started this, my mother did not have access to 24 hour care. Our Hospice home health aide, Maddy, makes her breakfast every morning. Maddy's learning a lot about ethnic food. My mother is very European," laughs Deb. "Maddy has been a lifesaver."



Regina loves to cook for her family.

Born Regina Katz on March 14, 1925, Regina was one of six children. With the arrival of the Hungarians to her town, there was little money or jobs available. So, Regina, at about 14 or 15 years old, and a brother, left their family to look for work in Budapest. Her parents sent their oldest child, Ruth, to America.

While working in Budapest, the Nazis came and things changed. The Jewish family Regina was working for bought false Swiss papers for themselves and Regina and hid for awhile. A neighbor reported the family's location to the Nazi soldiers. It was 1944 when Regina was taken.

"They took us from there to Bergen Belsen," recalls Regina. "That was the concentration camp where Anne Frank died," added Deb.

"That was in the winter. It was so cold," remembers Regina. "They took away our clothes and they gave us these striped clothes with a number on it."

"The commandant of the concentration camp would line people up for hours outside and if you shook too much, he would shoot them," said Deb. "Selapel" replied Regina, remembering the name of the horrible activity that happened almost daily for hours on end. "I was very sick and they let us stay a good long while and freeze. Some women fell down to their knees. But I was lucky, I had such friends that they moved to hold me up between them in the line so that the soldiers wouldn't see I was shaking."

"My mother is also using Hospice's chaplain, Mary Ann. She loves to talk to her. She also loves the music therapist Abby and the massage therapist who comes." "She could come a little more," adds Regina with a chuckle.

"Hospice has been supportive in terms of sending a lab technician to draw blood for us, as Regina is on Coumadin. At this point, it takes so much effort to leave the house for medical care, the fact that Hospice provides some home health support is really critical," added Deb.

The family has found that Hospice gives them the help they need to enable Regina to remain in the comfort of her home. One of the unique aspects of Hospice care is the ability to hear and learn from patient's experiences. With this in mind, Regina was willing to share her life story, saying "with the hope that this helps Hospice."

The Best Decision We Ever Made

For 52 year-old Lisa Church, Hospice equaled death, or so she thought. “It was the end of the road. That’s how I viewed it,” Church said as she spoke to a group of 3rd year medical students recently at the Hospice Mitchell Campus. “Hospice is giving me life. The fact that I could walk from the parking lot to here is incredible.”

The Lancaster mother was admitted to Hospice home care in late January of this year. She was experiencing great discomfort from her colorectal tumor and was unable to get out of bed. Thankfully, Hospice physician, Elizabeth Maher, M.D., FACP, recommended a simple set of treatments to relieve her discomfort.

“I am utterly at peace,” Church explained. “I know that God is in control and that He heals. If He heals me on this side, I win. If He heals me on the other side, I win. God and Hospice working together have radically improved my life. God holds my days. None of us ever thought Hospice equaled life. It has truly improved my life.”

“Lisa’s situation shows us that Hospice with attention to relatively simple symptom management can make a meaningful change in how a person enjoys life,” noted Dr. Maher.

Currently, Lisa Church is working on a journal for her daughter and makes it a point to welcome every person who comes to her home. “My goal now is to leave a legacy,” she said. “I view every person who comes to my house, as a beautifully wrapped present. It doesn’t matter what I look like, or what time it is, I welcome that person into my home. I enjoy unwrapping the gift, that is, getting to know that person and finding out what is going on in their lives. It is such a honor and privilege spending time with them. It is a gift.”

Lisa left a legacy of “grace in the face of illness” with everyone she met.

Lisa passed away peacefully surrounded by family and friends on April 4, 2011. ■

Help for You and Your Family

If you or someone you know is going through the loss of a loved one, you may experience grief in different forms. These may include a range of feelings such as sadness, loneliness, anger, and fear. Sometimes, these feelings can get overwhelming, and you may need support from others during this time in your life.

Life Transitions Center, located at 150 Bennett Road in Cheektowaga offers support groups for adults, teens and children.

Upcoming sessions for adults include:

- **General Grief Support Group** – A support group for adults who have experienced the death of a loved one.
- **Widowed Persons Over 50** – Support for people who have experienced the death of a spouse within the past 18 months.
- **Widowed Persons Under 50** – Support for people 50 years of age or younger who have experienced the death of a spouse within the past 18 months.
- **After a Parent Dies** – Support for adults who have experienced the death of a parent within the past 2 years.

Upcoming sessions for children and teens:

- **Plant Kid/Planet Teen** – A therapeutic program for children ages 5-11 and teens ages 12-18 who have lost a loved one. Participants get involved in creative activities, movies, pizza and have the opportunity to share their feelings related to the loss of their loved one.

Resilient Elder Loves Hospice

The barracks where Regina lived had a “Tower of Babel” feel to it as the people in the barracks came from different countries and were unable to communicate with each other.¹

Because of this, Regina picked up many languages and has the ability to understand most Slavic and romance languages. She translated for the people in the barracks to the German officers.

“They gave us a slice of bread every 3 days. I got my bread and said no one is going to steal my bread so I ate it all,” recalled Regina. When the allies began liberating the concentration camps, the Nazis moved Regina along with 800 other survivors in cattle cars to another camp. They spent days in the cattle cars traveling through stations and suffering through horrible conditions. Some of Regina’s friends and others died while enroute to the new camp, Theresienstadt.

Shortly after her arrival, Regina was liberated. She weighed eighty pounds. She does not remember the liberation because she had typhus. Many of her friends who had lived through the concentration camps died of typhus after liberation. Regina had spent 1½ years in captivity. She was 17 years old.

Regina returned to Budapest where she found her brother Herman. They both went back to Slajenskadoli (a town in the Czech Republic) where they found their sister, Lily, and their brother, Zedel. Others in the town told her that her mother and her sister died at Auschwitz. She was told that her father was killed at Buchenwald just hours before liberation.

“Awhile ago I didn’t want to think about it,” said Regina. “But now I am able to talk about it.”

Regina married another survivor, Frank Markowitz, now deceased. They have 4 children, 9 grandchildren and 5 great grandchildren.

“My 12 year-old granddaughter who lives in Israel took a school trip to the concentration camp and to clean up the cemeteries in Poland. When she came home, she told my daughter, ‘Call Grandma and tell her that she won,’” said Regina. “Why did I win? I’m alive.” ■

¹ Tower of Babel: in the Bible, a tower that people started to build too tall, causing God to show his anger by making them speak different languages, which led to the collapse of the project and ultimately to the scattering of people across the world; a place or situation that is very confusing because there is too much information and no easy way to understand it.

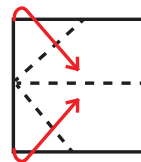

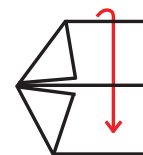
make your own peace dove.

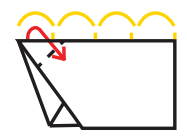
your peace message:



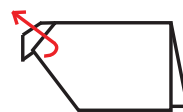
1. Fold in half into a rectangle and unfold again to lay flat. Fold two corners in to meet at the center line.

3. Fold head down, about 1/4 of the distance of the top edge, creasing well.



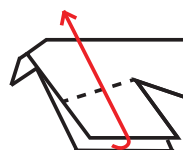
4. Fold head backwards on the same crease again creasing well.



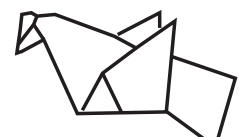
5. Return head to original position and push down on the top fold, reversing the middle crease.



6. Draw a triangle shape and cut away shaded area to make the wing and tail.



7. Fold up one wing. Turn over and fold up other wing.
